5. <u>CITY BUDGET</u> : What are your proposals to keep the City of Poway's budget in check while also maintaining Poway's 'CITY IN THE COUNTRY' atmosphere as much as possible?		<u>FIRST</u> : Have a conservative city operations budget that will maintain our quality of life. <u>SECOND</u> : Downsize or consolidate city sponsored events. <u>THIRD</u> : Consider fees or fee increases for some city services There would be no cuts in public safety and emergency responder services.
6. <u>EMPTY STOREFRONTS</u>: To what do you attribute the ongoing glut of empty storefronts along Poway Road? Also, if elected, what would yo propose to fix this?		The longtime, ongoing conventional City Hall view is that economic forces and demand will dictate the business viability of the Poway Road corridor. I would work with the Economic Development Office, Poway Chamber of Commerce and Poway Road businesses to modernize locations and recruit new businesses.
7. UNANIMOUS VOTES: The vas majority of city council votes are unan- imous. Why do you think this is? Also if elected, will you be willing to vote in the minority if you conclude that is the right thing to do for Poway and its resi- dents?	YES	Majority votes can be a result of "group think" with no individual perspective on the issue. Also, if council members challenged some city staff recommendations, voting patterns would be different.
8. LIVE BROADCASTS: Poway is the only North County city without LIVE CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS ON CABLE and/or LIVE WEBSTREAMING. This was a cam- paign promise made in 2004 and again in 2006. If elected, will you work to make this happen as soon as possible?	YES	I would need three votes. If costs aren't prohibitive, I always advocate open, inclusive accountable city government. Live televised meetings are a good final step.
9. SOUTH POWAY ISSUES: Most City Council Members and can- didates are North Poway residents. If elected, what will you do to ensure tha vital South Poway issues are not short changed?		This is another ongoing community concern that requires city council/political leadership. This North-South divide is very counter-productive to the stewardship and governance of Poway. If elected, I will represent all of Poway.
