

Memorandum of Agreement

The South Poway Residents Association and the Green Valley Civic Association agree to cooperate in a joint effort to promote the preservation and acquisition of parkland and open space within the City of Poway and to protect the Poway General Plan.

Both organizations recognize the importance that open space and parkland have on the quality of life within our City. As Poway reaches build out, we realize that there will be increasing pressure to develop the remaining land, bringing with it the significant risk for adverse effects on existing residents. We therefore believe it is in the best interest of the members of both organizations, and of all the citizens of Poway, that our two Associations cooperate and coordinate our efforts to enlighten the public and encourage our civic leaders to protect the tenets of the General Plan and adopt positions that promote parkland and open space.


The initial focus of this joint effort will be:

1. Acquisition of 8 acres for parkland in the Old Coach area in conjunction with the Sunroad development
2. Concerns about loss of open space and the precedent that may result from the Slough development in the South Poway Planned Community
3. Acquisition of additional park space south of Poway Road

The Green Valley Civic Association and the South Poway Residents Association agree to work together to preserve the rural qualities that remain within our City and minimize the impacts of new development on existing residents.

In order to prevent confusion, neither organization shall indicate that they represent the position of the other, either orally or in writing, unless they have received written permission to do so by the leader of that organization.


